



VISA INFORMATION FOR VISITORS TO KENYA & TANZANIA

PASSPORT AND VISA INFORMATION

Your passport needs to be valid for **at least six (6) months** after your journey ends, and should have a minimum of two (2) blank visa pages for entry and exit stamps.

KENYA

An Electronic Travel Authority (eTA) is required for all nationalities including U.S. and Canadian passport holders for entry into Kenya and must be obtained prior to departure. To apply for an eTA, please visit the link below:

www.etakenya.go.ke

Note: Guests who currently have a valid Kenya e-visa issued for travel in 2024 (including children under 18 travelling with e-Visa holders) may use the e-visa to enter Kenya and do not have to apply for an eTA.

The current fee is US \$30 plus a \$2.50 service charge (subject to change without notice) and is valid for one journey/single entry and expires upon exiting Kenya. Guests travelling on a journey that enters Kenya multiple times (after visiting either Tanzania, Uganda or Rwanda) only need to secure the initial eTA. On arrival in Kenya, they will receive a Visitor's Pass that will allow them re-entry into Kenya after visiting other countries.

Kenya eTA applications should be submitted at least 3 days prior to travel to ensure adequate time for authorization. Travellers can submit their applications up to 3 months prior to travel. It is highly recommended that travellers apply as soon as possible after they have booked their Kenya travel arrangements. Children under the age of 18 must travel with an eTA, and the legal guardian, parent or accompanying adult is responsible for filling out their application.

You will need the following information prior to applying for Kenya eTA:

- **Passport:** Valid for at least six (6) months after your arrival date in Kenya with at least one blank page.
- **Photo:** A selfie or passport-type photo.
- **Contact information:** Home address, email address and phone number.
- **Details of arrival and departure:** Arrival flight number, date of departure of initial flight in case of connecting flights.
- **Accommodation:** Hotel booking confirmations (travel itinerary).
- **Payment:** Credit/debit card, Apple Pay, etc.

Once you submit the application, you will receive a confirmation email that your application and payment has been received. This email will contain the reference number assigned to your application. You will receive another email once your application has been approved. You can check the status of your application at any time by visiting: <https://www.etakenya.go.ke>. Use your reference number to check your application status.

If approved, save the eTA (sent as a PDF) on your mobile device and also print it out. Your electronic travel authorization needs to be shown at all departure and arrival points. For travellers who have an Android phone there is the option to store your approved eTA in the "Kenya Travel Authorization" mobile app. You can download the app for free Google Play Store. The app is currently not available in the Apple Store.



TANZANIA

A tourist visa is required for all nationalities including U.S. and Canadian passport holders for entry into Tanzania. We recommend an electronic visa (eVisa).

U.S. citizens visiting Tanzania for tourism are required to apply for a multiple-entry visa, which is valid for one year. The cost is USD \$100 (subject to change without notice). Citizens of Canada and rest of the world may obtain a single-entry e-Visa (ordinary visa), valid for three months. The cost is \$USD 50 (subject to change). We recommend that you apply at least 60 days prior to your arrival date. Average time to receive an eVisa is approximately 10 days.

When applying for your eVisa make sure you have your passport details, a copy of your passport photo and return ticket, as you will need to upload these documents to complete the application process. Read and follow all instructions carefully to ensure a smooth arrival in Tanzania.

Complete the "Travel Information" section of the on-line application as indicated below:

1. Type of Visa: Multiple entry (U.S. citizens); Single-entry/Ordinary (Canadian citizens and rest of the world)
2. Purpose of Visit: "Leisure and Holiday"
3. Port Type: Choose either "Airports" or "Roads"
4. Port of Entry and Port of Departure: These specific ports may be left blank
5. Date of Arrival: Enter your date of entry for Tanzania
6. Departure Date: Enter your departure date from Tanzania
7. Host Details: Select "Company/Organization"
8. Full names and Address of the Host:

14. Where are you going to stay? Choose hotel from the dropdown menu and then enter the contact information of the first hotel on your itinerary.

YELLOW FEVER VACCINATION AND MALARIA PREVENTION

A yellow fever vaccination is only required to enter **Kenya** if you are arriving from, or have transited through, a yellow fever-endemic area in South America or Africa—including East African countries such as Kenya and Uganda.

A yellow fever certificate for **Tanzania (including Zanzibar)** is required regardless of which country you are arriving from and it is a must to present the certificate upon arrival to the respective border post/airport officials in order to enter the country.

The CDC and WHO each provide a current list of all affected countries. As your itinerary includes visits to both Kenya and Tanzania, vaccination for yellow fever is necessary and you must carry an International Certificate of Vaccination provided by your physician; you may be denied entry without it. If your physician advises against receiving the vaccination because of your personal medical history, he or she can provide you with the necessary documentation for the country/countries you are visiting.

You will be travelling to areas of malaria transmission. We strongly advise that you speak with your doctor or travel clinic regarding your itinerary, individual risk assessment and options for mosquito bite prevention and antimalarial drugs. We recommend filling any prescriptions before you depart.
